We want to let you know that we are aware and staying up to date on the developing news surrounding cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Texas and specifically in Harris, Montgomery, Waller and Fort Bend Counties. We are monitoring the situation and following the official recommendations of the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). This is a top priority for our church family.

At this time, the DSHS is not recommending any building or event closures, and so at this point, we have no plans to close our church campus or cancel any of our service experiences. In addition to our regularly scheduled cleaning for our facilities, we are also being proactive with additional cleaning and sanitizing of areas that experience high levels of contact. We are also going the extra mile in our ChampKids City classes by thoroughly sanitizing the spaces before and after each service, as well as throughout the week to protect a healthy classroom environment. We will continue to closely monitor the situation and provide any updates via email and social media.



# WELLNESS POLICY

Thank you for entrusting us to care for and teach your children each week. We do everything we can to keep a healthy and safe environment for your child, but we need your help! Please help us by complying with the following health guidelines.

Your child should not be in ChampKids City if they have any of the following symptoms:

- A fever of 100 or higher (taken under the arm) or 101 taken orally in the last 24 hours
- Must not have had fever reducing medication within the last 24 hours
- Diarrhea (more than twice in a 24hr period)
- Rash with fever
- Cold sores
- Sore throat
- Eye discharge (thick mucus or pus draining from the eye)
- Vomiting
- Severe cough

To help prevent the spreading of germs, if one of our ChampKids City team members notices your child experiencing any of the above symptoms, we will contact you to come pick them up. Thank you for partnering with us to protect and create a healthy environment for your kids!
